Meeting called to order 7:14

PRESIDENT: Dennis Young

Welcome new members and others who have joined. Tonight, we will review the budget and go over the P&L for the 2019-20 season. Club did very well, and you'll see that when we review the report.

SKI VICE PRESIDENT: Ron Levine

Couple of nice trips this year. Industry gearing up with plans to limit crowds. Gondolas may be limited to family groups only. Adrienne's trip to Vail is Jan 23-30 and she will speak about that

Adrienne Geffen: Air is nonstop from Newark to Eagle Vale. Staying at Evergreen lodge (close to Lion's Head). Those with the EPIC pass or group tickets will be given priority. Epic pass is only available until Sept. 9. Those interested should contact me immediately and send me a check to hold your place. I need to make a decision. If there's not enough people, I will cancel. I plan to make a decision by Labor Day. Vail is opening this season. If we have a group tickets, we can ski. Have not been able to get group ticket price but last year was about 50 percent more than EPIC price.

Ron Levine: Industry offering cancellation refunds when trips are cancelled 90 days out. So, with the Vail trip, that would be by end of October. If you wish to cancel by then you will get your money back.

Adrienne: That is true but not for the EPIC pass. They will refund if Vail is closed. Have not given out prices for lift tickets yet. They refuse to push back deadline for purchasing EPIC pass

Other trips are also planned:

- Sunday River, Maine, March 7-12 at an incredible affordable price. Runs around four or five hundred dollars
- Ski Council has a trip to Mt. Tremblant, but they've closed that out right now. Border is closed right now and not likely to open until the first of the year
- Big Sky trip, Feb. 13-20. Lodging at the Summit, Huntley, and other condos. Still have some openings. Right now, 116 people have signed up. No more nonstop flights are available. There are some one stop flights available on United
- Can still do bus trips over the winter. We can do these on a two-week notice. Skiing will be open and we will take advantage
- Anyone interested in signing up for Sunday River or to be waitlisted for Mt. Tremblant should contact Dennis.

LODGE VP: Ray Owens

We are meeting next week with lodge committee to discuss two plans that we are considering for the lodge. Also hearing new information like:

• Ski areas may open only for those with reservations and shareholders

- Ramapo Ski Club indicating that Mad River Glen doesn't expect ski lodges to open
- Stowe, Okemo, Mt. Snow may be going same way as Vail with opening just for season passes and reservations
- Ramapo Ski Club is tackling same problems. Will require social distancing and masks.
 May close kitchen and require individuals to bring their own food. May allow just use of Microwave
- Biggest concern is whether or not we can open the lodge and keep it safe. That's the
 most important. Don't want to be in charge of this lodge if someone gets sick. That's
 what's taking time
- Vermont requires maximum 50% occupancy, has quarantine rules and requires
 certificate of compliance from every member. The have an alert called Sara Alert that
 you sign up for. They then check on you every day to see how you are doing

- Big Sky trip took place with 14 people attending. Resort was very accommodating and good to us
- Mix B4 6 next Tuesday at 5;30 at Maywood Inn Twin Doors. They have a 20x70 tent with a bar setup. Dinner is available. Wear a mask. Should have a good time
- Car Hops have been good but it's getting late in the season to continue them. May do another mix in September.

- May do a questionnaire on what members want to do. Will help us plan
